TerraData shareholders published some 253 papers on ISI journals between 2007 and 2015, with a cumulated Impact Factor (IF) of 583. The mean H Index in 2016 was 15.5 (min: 7; max: 25). Citing articles (without selfcitation) were 693 (161-1634).





TerraData organized, co-organized and attended dozens of scientific events worldwide. TerraData has been coorganizing the Scientific Conferences of the ICP Forests since 2011. Several reports and Special Issues on international journals were published after these initiatives.
